Proceeds will benefit **My Sister's House**, the only organization in the Central Valley that provides shelter and supportive programs to Asian Pacific Islander women and their children who are victims of domestic violence. **The profits from this event will help provide 5001 nights of safety for one year.** For 10 years, My Sister's House has provided over 17,000 nights of shelter at its 6-bed safe haven. In addition to culturally sensitive shelter and job skills training, they also provide a 24/7 multi-lingual help line, a legal advice clinic, and referrals to health and mental health services. As well, My Sister's House conducts community-wide outreach and education on domestic violence and human trafficking to help prevent abuse in the home. In August 2012 My Sister's House opened its transitional home to assist clients to stabilize their lives during an extended stay at home. Although its focus is on survivors and victims who identify with Asian Pacific Islander culture and language, My Sister's House saves the lives of women and children threatened by domestic violence from all backgrounds.
