The Boys and Men of Color Partnerships would like to invite you to submit a proposal to present at the 2014 Boys and Men of Color (BMoC) Summit on June 26<sup>th</sup> at Sacramento State. We will be hosting nearly 150 young men and mentors alongside many adult allies.

This year's theme is "**Becoming Men of Change.**" The mission of this summit is to create system's change by gathering boys and men of color to take community action by making concrete steps toward improving the health, safety and educational outcomes of young men in Sacramento. The conference will include a keynote, workshops, various artists/performers and access to campus tours as well as free food!

For this year's conference, we have 3 different workshop topics for which we are seeking facilitators. The following topics include, but are not limited to, some key highlighted themes. These topics were selected by our youth committee and provide descriptions only as a starting point for the facilitators to brainstorm from. The facilitator's workshop can encompass more content according to the facilitator's creativity and expertise.

**Workshop 1 – Respect, Stereotypes & Judgments....Where do I Fit In?**

This workshop will focus on addressing Privilege, Power, BMoC Stereotypes and culture around judgment and the impact on young men. How do young men of color navigate through a society that judges them on first sight?

**Workshop 2 – Everyone uses the "N" Word...so it's ok, Right????**

Presenters will educate participants on the origin and consequence of the "N" Word. They will give youth the opportunity to explore their reasons for using the "N" Word why the word is used by all ethnic cultures and what the impact that has on society. Based on the presentation youth should have the opportunity to determine how they feel about the word and the impact it has themselves and others when used.

**Workshop 3 – Think Before You Act...It Might Change Your Life**

The presenter will develop a work shop that will help youth identify their self-worth and value, what it means to make a right choice, and discuss how consequences are both positive and negative and why decision making needs to involve outcome and long term consequences.

**Boys and Men of Color Partnership** invites you to submit a workshop proposal that describes the content, your experience and the intended outcome for participants that attend your workshop.

It is our expectation that workshop presenters will:

- Conduct a workshop that last no more than 60 minutes
- Bring enough material for workshop participants
- Ensure that the workshop is interactive and engaging for participants
- Presenters are strongly encouraged, but not required, to participate throughout the duration of the conference from 8:30am-5:00pm.
- As a workshop presenter, your name, organization and workshop details will also be included in the summit program, distributed to all attendees at the summit. This information will also be added to the summit website, two weeks prior to the event start date.

### **Workshop Audio/Visual Equipment**

Each workshop room has the capability to be equipped with a screen, LCD projector, sound capability for your laptop and flipchart with markers, if needed for your workshop. We do ask that when submitting your workshop application, you make note of what items you will need to run your workshop successfully.

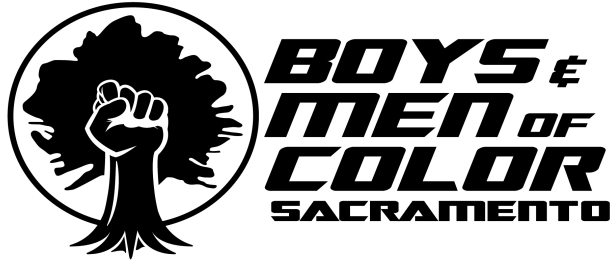
