Also, there is a Homeless Youth Task Force meeting on Tuesday January 29th from 3-4pm at Wind Youth Services, located at 701 Dixieanne Ave. Sacramento, CA 95815. Snacks will be provided. The meeting is open to anyone interested in youth homelessness in Sacramento.

Three questions will be considered during the meeting.

1. What are the greatest barriers that prevent youth (12-24 years old) from accessing services they need in Sacramento?
2. What specific strategies and services can each of us bring to the table individually to eliminate the barriers and improve services?
3. What specific strategies can an inter-agency group like us work on together to eliminate barriers and improve services?
